

Additional Competition rules by Age Group

Under 11s

Group Stage

Under 12s

Group Stage

Groups A to D will play each other once a result must be achieved on the day. If scores level at end of normal time then each team receive 1 point each, an additional point will then be awarded to the team winning the penalty shoot out as per FA rules.

Group E will initially play each other once and then two additional fixtures have been added against another team totalling 7 games. **(In place before competition starts)**

Win	3pts
Draw	1pt
Penalty shoot out win	1pt

For the knockout stage the following will apply

The top two in Groups A and B will qualify for the quarter finals along with the winners of Group C and D

The Runners up in Group C and D and Winners and runners up of Group E will go into a play off with the 2 winners joining the teams receiving a bye to the quarter finals.

All KO stage games will be played to a finish on the day. If scores are level at the end on normal time then the winner will be decided by the taking of penalty kicks in accordance with FA Laws

Under 13s

Group Stage

Group A and B will play 6 games. All teams play each other once (for Groups C and D see below) and a result must be achieved on the day. If scores level at end of normal time then each team receive 1 point each, an additional point will then be awarded to the team winning the penalty shoot out as per FA rules.

Group C and D will initially play each other once and then one additional fixtures have been added against another team totalling 6 games. **(In place before competition starts)**

Win	3pts
Draw	1pt
Penalty shoot out win	1pt

All group winners and runners up will advance to the KO stage of the competition. In case of a tie in the group stages the position will be decided on result between teams (if it was a draw then the winner of the penalty shoot out will be deemed the winner of that tie). Then the result of the teams concerned against the top placed team or next best placed team. (The decision of the committee is final in this case)

All KO stage games will be played to a finish on the day. If scores are level at the end on normal time then the winner will be decided by the taking of penalty kicks in accordance with FA Laws

Under 14s
Group Stage

All teams play each other once a result must be achieved on the day. If scores level at end of normal time then each team receive 1 point each, an additional point will then be awarded to the team winning the penalty shoot out as per FA rules.

Win	3pts
Draw	1pt
Penalty shoot out win	1pt

Group winners and runners up will progress to KO stage. In case of a tie for any place the position will be decided on result between teams (if it was a draw then the winner of the penalty shoot out will be deemed the winner of that tie).

Then the result of the teams concerned against the top placed team or next best placed team. (The decision of the committee is final in this case)

All KO stage games will be played to a finish on the day. If scores are level at the end on normal time then the winner will be decided by the taking of penalty kicks in accordance with FA Laws

Under 15s
Group Stage

All teams play each other once a result must be achieved on the day. If scores level at end of normal time then each team receive 1 point each, an additional point will then be awarded to the team winning the penalty shoot out as per FA rules.

Win	3pts
Draw	1pt
Penalty shoot out win	1pt

Group winners and runners up will progress to KO stage plus best two 3rd place teams.

In case of a tie for any place the position will be decided on result between teams (if it was a draw then the winner of the penalty shoot out will be deemed the winner of that tie).

Then the result of the teams concerned against the top placed team or next best placed team. (The decision of the committee is final in this case)

All KO stage games will be played to a finish on the day. If scores are level at the end on normal time then the winner will be decided by the taking of penalty kicks in accordance with FA Laws

Under 16s
Group Stage

Groups A to D will play each other once a result must be achieved on the day. If scores level at end of normal time then each team receive 1 point each, an additional point will then be awarded to the team winning the penalty shoot out as per FA rules.

Group E will initially play each other once and then two additional fixtures have been added against another team totalling 7 games. **(In place before competition starts)**

Draw	1pt
Penalty shoot out win	1pt

For the knockout stage the following will apply

The top two in Groups A and B will qualify for the quarter finals along with the winners of Group C and D

The Runners up in Group C and D and 3rd place teams in group A and B will play Off for the 2 remaining quarter final places
